Neutral Position (NP) changes to Westpac Diversified investment options Effective 25 November 2020

To ensure that the range of investment funds within our product offerings continue to suit the investment needs of our members, we regularly monitor and review our investments. In response to a recent review, the fund manager, Pendal Group Limited (Pendal), has made changes to the Neutral Positions (NPs) for multiple Westpac super and investment accounts. The NP changes will allow Pendal to better position the investment options to take advantage of future market conditions.
